FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT, DOCUMENT LISTING & POLICY

The following information is provided by the Auburn Fire & Rescue District pursuant to Sections 4 and 5 of the Illinois Freedom of Information Action (5 ILCS 140/4 & 5):

1. Descriptive Statement:

- a. The Auburn Fire & Rescue District is a public fire protection district organized and operating under the provisions of the Illinois Fire Protection District Act (70 ILCS 705/0.01 et seq.)
- b. It is located in Sangamon County.
- c. It operates a fire department from the following locations: 117 West Jackson, 300 N. 5th Street and 1308 W. Jefferson, Auburn, Illinois, 62615.
- d. The mailing address of the district is 117 West Jackson, P.O. Box 347, Auburn, Illinois, 62615.
- e. Persons desiring to contact the district may contact Dave Moose, 890 Eastland Drive Auburn Illinois, 62615. During the time period from January 1 through March 15th correspondence should be addressed to Bill Atteberry, 720 W. Van Buren, Auburn Illinois, 62615
- f. The district is governed by a Board of Trustees consisting of five persons. Meetings of the Board are held on the second Tuesday of each month.
- g. The approximate budget of the district is \$105,000.00 annually.

2. The district maintains the following types and categories of records:

- a. General Ordinances
- b. Budget and Appropriations Ordinances adopted annually.
- c. Property Tax Levy Ordinances adopted annually.
- d. Financial Reports prepared annually.
- e. Minutes of meetings of the Board of Trustees and Treasurer's Reports.
